- □Target groups: teaching staff, administrative staff
- □ An advocacy campaign will be developed to encourage influential stakeholders to join and support activities of internationalization by innovative technologies in Israeli HEIs.
- □ Materials (national level & translated to Hebrew and Arabic):
 - □seminars (F2F, online)
 - presentations
 - publications
- □ Three meetings: The Israeli partners will convene in three different points of time, during the project lifetime, to discuss options and alternatives for effective advocacy campaign



Development and launch of professional help desk

- A service/product (on-going)
 - ■Due date: 14/10/2018
 - □Target groups: teaching staff, administrative staff
- □ Ensuring consistent sustainable maintenance based on information and support to end users
- □Based on:
 - □Digital manuals available to users
 - □Crowdsource technical support of discussion boards and forums
 - □Q&A website that keeps a database of questions and answers that users can search and add to in an ongoing process of development
