

It includes the academic knowledge, study skills and English language ability required **to succeed as a vocational degree student.**

The International Year One will progress onto 3rd term, Year 1 of:
Business Management BSc with business experience

So much more than a traditional degree

The integrated programme includes **a degree**, **business experience**, and a path towards **professional membership** – all in just three years, and for the same fee as a traditional degree!

A combination that gives students the **knowledge, skills** and **practical experience** that employers look for.

Professional qualifications include: **PRINCE2**, **CMI**, and students get a **22 day programme of pre-business experience sessions**, so they are fully prepared for the world of work.

Human Resource Management; Entrepreneurship; Finance; or Service Operations


