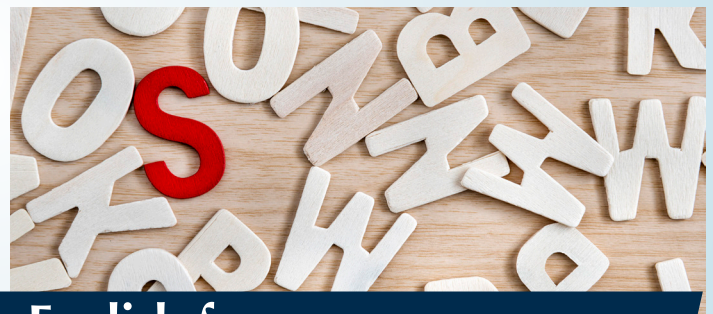
Global Entrepreneurship
