







# In2lt Workshop 6-8 February 2017 PARTICIPANTS INFORMATION

Dear IN2IT project partners this pocket participants information document would be a small introduction to Milan just before your arrival. We do hope could be useful to provide you all relevant information to make your working days in Milan comfortable and get the chance to profit as much as you can from your stay.

#### Arrival

There are three airports serving Milan: Malpensa, Linate and Orio al Serio (Bergamo).

# Malpensa to Milan

Taxi transfers to the city centre: €80-€100

Malpensa Express – a train shuttle service to Cadorna Station in Milan: €12

Shuttle Bus service to Milan Central Station: €10 (about 60 minutes)

#### Linate to Milan

Taxi to the city centre: approx. €20-€25 depending on address

Bus 73 to city centre – Piazza S. Babila: €1.50 (ticket machine at bus stop)

From Piazza San Babila you will easily reach your hotels by taking the Metro Red Line 1 until Cadorna

stop and then walk less than 10 minutes to Corso Magenta. (see the map at page 3)

#### Orio al Serio (Bergamo)

Taxi to Milan city centre: €80-€100

Shuttle Bus service to Milan Central Station: €5 (45-60 minutes)

#### 2. Once in Milan...

#### **TRANSPORTS**

ATM (Azienda Trasporti Milanesi) manages the public transport service of the city of Milan. It provides underground train, urban and interurban tramway and bus, trolley bus and airport transfer services.

## Tickets

Tickets can be bought from newsagents and directly at the stations tickets machine.


In general, Urban ticket single ride is 1.50 Euro. There are other possible solutions that can be either convenient as for example 2X6 ticket: 2 ride a day for 6 days. Otherwise, One day tickets or Two-days ticket. Please be aware that a ticket, after validation, will last for 70 minutes.

#### Metro

Metro services operate between 6.00 am and midnight and cover four lines:

- Line 1 (Red Line) runs from Sesto 1 Maggio FS to Rho-Fiera and Bisceglie
  The stop CADORNA is near the University and CHEI Building (see the map)
- Line 2 (Green) connects Abbiategrasso / Assago and Gessate /Cologno Nord
  The stops CADORNA and SANT'AMBROGIO are near the University and the CHEI building (see the map)
- Line 3 (Yellow) runs from S. Donato to Comasina
- Line 5 (Lilac) runs from San Siro stadium to Bignami

#### The Metro Rail net




## 3. Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore campus


Università Cattolica del Sacro Cuore is characterized by a campus extending in several buildings situated near the Basilica of Sant'Ambrogio in the heart of Milan.

Free wi-fi access will be provided and coffee break during the meetings will be offered by UCSC.




# The Via Carducci Building



# 4. For Lunch breaks nearby UCSC


There's a good choice of cafés near the university that you can get to quite quickly during the lunch break.
