Tasks (T9.1)



Preparation of a sustainability and exploitation work plan that will define all the relevant stakeholders well as the appropriate approaches to sustain the project's results and to increase its impact and include action items, roles and responsibilities.





Tasks (T9.2)



Establishment of an international network of stakeholders including faculty members, IRO
professionals, IT staff, students, as well as HE policy
makers, representatives of research agencies and
project funds, will be designed and developed
throughout the advanced stages of the project as a
framework for further connections and partnerships.

The development of the international network of stakeholders is an on-going task that will be carried on under the leadership of KC to keep the network relevant and updated.





Tasks (T9.3)



Development and delivery of an advocacy campaign, mainly targeted at decision makers in the Israeli HE system and at top management in the colleges, to encourage them to join and support activities of internationalization by innovative technologies in Israeli HEIs.

Materials will include seminars, presentations and publications at national level, translated to Hebrew and Arabic.

In 3 meetings of the Israeli partners options and alternatives for effective advocacy campaign will be discussed.





Tasks (T9.4)



Development and launch of professional help desk, based mainly on digital manuals available to users, crowdsource technical support of discussion boards and forums, and Q&A website that keeps a database of questions and answers that users can search and add to in an ongoing process of development. Those help desk facilities will enable continuous support to the innovative technologies of IN2IT while utilizing low level of resources allocation.




