




(2017-2018)




Gender Distribution –

(2017-2018)



Gender Distribution of Undergraduate Students by Subject

College Scholarships for Women:


The college awards several scholarships intended to encourage women to enter male-dominated fields:

- **Scholarship to Empower Women in Engineering (from the College Budget):** This scholarship grants NIS 2,000 to female students in the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering and the Department of Mechanical Engineering. During the **2015-2016** academic year, 28 of these scholarships were awarded. The scholarships are intended to encourage women to study fields that currently have low female representation, stemming from the belief that women can make a significant, influential contribution to these fields.
- **Elyashiv Family Scholarship in Memory of Jacob Levkovich:** This year, five scholarships were awarded to women facing financial hardship who are students in the Department of Electrical & Electronics Engineering and the Department of Mechanical Engineering. Each scholarship, in the amount of NIS 10,000, is kindly donated by the Elyashiv family.
- **NA'AMAT Scholarships:** Offered to female students from their second year of membership in the Histadrut trade union.


“Preparing Braude Women for the Hi-Tech World” is a 5-session workshop that includes a tour of Sanmina Medical Systems in Ma’alot, held in cooperation with Derech Isha.

The overarching aim of this workshop is to empower female students to maximize their own inherent potential, while also equipping them with essential tools for effective leadership and career management.



“Entering the Workforce from a Gender Perspective” Workshop

Every year, the college runs a gender-oriented workshop entitled “Entering the Workforce from a Gender Perspective.” The workshop is led by two women who are both highly-regarded external experts – an organizational consultant and a gender studies specialist. It is offered to second and fourth-year female students in all academic departments, and participants are eligible to receive a NIS 500 scholarship.

The 16-hour workshop aims to discuss employment issues relevant to women, both as today’s students and as tomorrow’s engineers, in order to equip them with the tools they need to overcome unique obstacles in the workplace. The workshop includes a tour of the Philips facility, where the students meet female engineers who have achieved success in a hi-tech environment, and creates a dialogue regarding questions specifically related to how women can thrive in male-dominated fields. This year, some 14 female students participated in the workshop.
