Prof. Dr.-Ing. Reimund Neugebauer is – since 2012 - the 10th President of the Fraunhofer Society. He is responsible for research & development, corporate policy and international affairs. With his profound managing and R&D background he steadily steered Fraunhofer and its 74 institutes through SARS-CoV-2-pandemic and initiated various programs to keep capacities and support the industry's restart after lockdown. During his presidency Fraunhofer increased its workforce by around 10,000 staff member and its research budget to almost €3 billion.

Prof. Dr. Reimund Neugebauer is President of the Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft since 2012, before that he was the Director of the Fraunhofer Institute for Machine Tools and Forming Technology, and a scientist. Last year, he steadily steered Fraunhofer through the Covid19 crisis and initiated the Anti-Corona and Innopush programs following the principle of resilience and innovation. During his term as president, Fraunhofer increased its workforce by 10,000 and its research budget to almost €3 billion.
